

CWSC quick reference rules and guide 2021



To be carried in the registered ski boat at all times and is to be shown to all your guests. Further clarification is available from the CWSC Constitution, Rules and By-laws

1. Skiers and boat participants under the age of 16 must wear a buoyancy aid whilst on the boat
2. Skiers must drop off at the designated drop off buoys, including during the 1 boat rule
3. Boats must use the tick over lane (4mph) this includes when lake is empty
4. Ensure that skiers and inflatables do not cross the tick over zone whilst in use, ensure that skiers keep a safe distance from the tick over area.
5. **DO NOT** start off from your personal Jetty. Only to be done from Jetty adjacent the ski shack.
6. **DO NOT** ski into your personal Jetties
7. Passengers must not sit on the gunwales (Side of the boat) or any other part of the decking whilst the boat is in motion (whatever speed)
8. All skiing guests must be signed in prior to activity. Failure to do so will result in a £50 fine
9. Red Flag must be raised in the event of a fallen skier
10. Lane 1 is only to be used by licenced drivers
11. Maximum time on the water when boats are queing is 3 full laps of the lake or 10 minutes whichever is the shortest time
12. Inflatables **CAN** be used on 1 boat rule times on **Monday and Friday only**
13. All Ski boat drivers must have a valid SBDA licence of RYA Powerboat level 2 or higher
14. Only 3 boats out in lane 2 at any time
15. No Mooring on main jetty. Please moor in personal jetty if not in use
16. Air horns are to be used only if in an emergency / distress

1 Boat rule operating times

Monday and Friday - 7am – 4pm

Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday - 4pm – Sunset

Saturday and Sunday - 7am – 1pm

All Skiing will end at sunset
